DIRECTIONS TO LA JENCIA

- Take I-25 to Socorro.
- Turn onto Highway 60 towards Magdalena.
- After approximately 23 miles, turn right off Highway 60 onto a dirt road just after mile marker 116.
- After approximately 2.5 miles, make a sharp left (north) and follow the sign for La Jencia.
- Go straight for approximately 7 miles and cross final cattle guard.
- Park by entering the metal gate on the right in front of the trailer, follow signs to the planting site.
